Dear Mr. Weisberg,

I have recently read a very interesting and provocative book which I hope has already been brought to your attention. On the chance that there is some remote possibility that it has not I am writing you this letter.

The book is called "Were We Controlled". It deals with the implications of the mind-controlling devices which are being rapidly developed by scientists and the evidence which has been gathered by this anonymous author developing the theory that certain major individuals in the "Kennedy Assassination" were controlled. He develops his theory particularly around Lee Harvey Oswald, Jack Ruby, and Tino De Angelis. The very strange thing about this whole theory however is that he deals with the means in which these controlled minds (if controlled) would be triggered and one of the means he deals with which they would be assigned to their duties i.e. to assassinate Kennedy would be the telephone in which would be the voice programmed with their instruction signal. They would have no memory of this signal or any affect other than a distinct "feeling".

So you can see (if you have not already been aware of this knowledge) the implications that this would have with regards to the Dallas Police Chief Jesse Curry and the inability for anyone to contact the man for an hour and one-half the Sunday morning that Mr. Oswald was so coldly shot down. I.e. Being programmed as to when and where and all the other necessary data to bring the "accused assassin" into the range of another possibly controlled man. This is rather strange. That he does have such a hazy recollection of that time Sunday morning and the explanation for the inability to contact him just as the author for "Were We Controlled" explains that anyone programmed would have a very hazy recollection. There may be nothing to this but it is rather interesting that so many of the symptoms and possibilities of the controlled situation and personality are so present in your description of the situation and the personality of this police chief.
