Dear Mike,

Thank you for your assistance in advising the former Mary Ann Moorman of this project.

We believe, based primarily on a partial study at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, that Mary's picture does contain significant new evidence about the Kennedy assassination.

Negotiations have begun with the Jet Propulsion Laboratory in California to enhance and analyze the photo. JPL is one of the foremost image processing centers in the world, and one of its scientists served on the photo panel of the recent House Assassinations Committee.

He is familiar with Mary's original Polaroid and has seen a significantly better quality print which I located over a year ago. The "new" version is far clearer than any available from either AP or UPI; it apparently came from one of the prints made for Mary back in the 60s.

We would like to examine all copies Mary has. If we find the clearer print, we would make a slide transparency copy for use at JPL. Mary's pictures do not have to leave her possession at any time, but the copying will have to be done in Fort Worth.

Also, even though Mary sold her picture, she would retain all rights to copies made from her material.
