Dear Mr. Collela,

As you know, we have been in touch with Mr. Robert Selzer concerning a photograph of the John Kennedy assassination.

We have located a significantly clearer copy of the photograph than has ever been seen and we expect even clearer copies will soon be made available to us.

The House Assassinations Committee urged that in light of the acoustics evidence of a second gunman, the same photo should receive further study. The Committee's photo panel, of which Mr. Selzer was a member, only had the badly faded original to work with.

We believe the clear copy of the Mary Moorman photograph in our possession may contain very significant new evidence and we would like JPL, as a public service, to analyze and evaluate its contents. Mr. Selzer has indicated an interest in performing the work.

Due to the continuing controversy about the assassination, we suspect the Department of Justice would appreciate an <u>independent</u> evaluation of what may be strong new evidence.

Your report would be made public on KXAS-TV and the NBC television network. This project would also give the public a unique look at your operation and technical capabilities, as well as demonstrate the effectiveness of computer enhancement.
