I just received your books today, and look forward to reading them immediately. As I have said in the past, I've learned more from your work than all the other writers combined. I was most interested in your observation as to why my wife and I disagree about the assassination. Like yourself, I do not believe that the true story of who killed President Kennedy will ever be revealed. The important thing, I think, is that our government must be compelled to own up to the fact that they engaged in a massive coverup regarding the assassination of the President of the United States. The fact of this coverup is incontrovertible as you have shown in Post Mortem alone.
