After we spoke today I took a closer look at what had been sent me by the Memphis Bulk Mail Center.

Perhaps it means no more than the kinds of problems of which we spoke about which it is not possible to do anything, but there are other oddities I call to your attention.

This package of two books insured for \$17.00 was mailed December 2. The Memphis notice did not reach here until today. We replaced the shipment at the phoned request of the purchaser a long time ago.

Memphis omitted a number in writing the insurance number.

There was much more of the wrapper than was sent. Cutting is visible at the edges and my name and address were written in, whereas that is the opposed end of our envelopes.

It seems extraordinary to me that there would be a delay of more than two months in letting me know.

If you need more for filing the claim, please let me know and I'll dig it out of the files.

The check should be sent to use because we have made replacements.
