Post 2/22/67 Manchester Admits Book Has Errors

NEW YORK, Feb. 21 (UPI) Author William Manchester admitted today that there are t mistakes in his "The Death of t a President" but said they will be corrected in future editions of the book. First s Serialization of the book, f which will be published in t April, has resulted in a number of "objections," Manchester said, including the charge that he was wrong when he said all but one aide to President Kennedy ducked the swearing-in of President Johnson.

Time magazine published 19 photographs Monday taken by Kennedy photographer Maj. Cecil Stoughton to prove that five Kennedy aides, not including Stoughton, were pres-ent at the ceremony aboard the presidential jet at Dallas,

Nov. 22, 1963.

"It is entirely possible I have made a mistake," Manchester said in a telephone in terview with the New York World Journal Tribune.
