Manchester Admits Book Has Errors

NEW YORK, Feb. 21 (UPI) Author William Manchester admitted today that there are mistakes in his "The Death of a President" but said they will be corrected in future editions of the book. ^{F 1827} _{CHW 2}

Serialization of the book, which will be published in April, has resulted in a number of "objections," Manchester said, including the charge that he was wrong when he said all but one aide to President Kennedy ducked the swearing-in of President Johnson.

Time magazine published 19 photographs Monday taken by Kennedy photographer Maj. Cecil Stoughton to prove that five Kennedy aides, not including Stoughton, were present at the ceremony aboard the presidential jet at Dallas, Nov. 22, 1963.

"It is entirely possible I have made a mistake," Manchester said in a telephone interview with the New York World Journal Tribune.
