Have you seen "There Was A President?" NBC tapes negate completely (in my opinion) the possibility that MacNeil intercepted Oswald on front steps of TSBDB at 12:33 pm (Commission time). (MacNeil was on telephone in Parkland, for example, at 12:53 pm.)

Manchester may be just plain wrong on this, as he was on the O'Donnell story. However, someone needs to check with MacNeil. Since Oswald directed someone to a phone, & since that someone could not have been MacNeil, we have some interesting unanswered questions.

We know very well that if MacNeil had really intercepted Oswald, he (MacNeil) as a newsmen would have been bursting with the story. He (MacNeil) would also have been an extremely pertinent witness.

Neither of these things occurred.
