Publisher Drops Idea of Monthly JFK Newsletter

DETROIT, May 3 (UPI) — Plans for a monthly publication about the late President Kennedy and his family have been abandoned by a Detroit publisher.

Frank H. Gille, president of American Data Processing, Inc., said he has decided to publish a series of hard-cover magazines entitled "The Kennedy Phenomenon" instead of a monthly 12-page newsletter, Gille, who publishes a series

Gille, who publishes a series of technical and educational newsletters, had said in March that he would start the Kennedy letter this month because of the effect Mr. Kennedy and his family have had on American life.

The proposed newsletter had been advertised in the East. Gille said he received a request from a representative of the Kennedy family that it carry a notation that they were in no way connected with it.
