Manchester Book Tops Prize List

STRESA, Italy (AP) — The 1966 Dag Hammarskjold International Literary Prize was awarded yesterday to William Manchester, author of "Death of a President," about the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

The Hammarskjold cultural prize went to Clare Boothe Luce, former U.S. Ambassador to Italy.

The Artistic Prize was awarded to Conductor Leonard Bernstein of the New York Philharmonic Orchestra.

The prizes consist of gold medals and a parchment. They will be forwarded to the recipients.
