

## *Manchester Awarded Prize*

STRESA, Italy, April 23 (AP)—The 1966 Dag Hammarskjold International Literary Prize was awarded today to William Manchester, author of "The Death of a President," about the assassination of President Kennedy. None of the three was present at the award ceremony at the Congress Palace of this Lake Maggiore resort. The prizes, consisting of gold medals and a parchment, will be sent to the recipients.

The Hammarskjold Cultural Prize went to Clare Boothe Luce, former U.S. Ambassador to Italy.

The Artistic Prize was awarded to conductor Leonard Bernstein of the New York Philharmonic Orchestra.
