

Hammar skjold Literary Prize To Manchester

STRESA, Italy, April 24 (AP)

—The 1966 Dag Hammar skjold International Literary Prize has been awarded to William Manchester, author of "Death of a President," about the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

The Hammar skjold Cultural Prize went to Clare Boothe Luce, former U.S. ambassador to Italy.

The artistic prize was awarded to conductor Leonard Bernstein of the New York Philharmonic Orchestra.

None of the three was present at the award ceremony yesterday at the Congress Palace of this Lake Maggiore resort. The prizes, which consist of gold medals and a parchment, will be forwarded to the recipients.
