To Manchester STRESA, Italy, April 24 (AP) —The 1966 Dag Hammarskjold International Literary Prize has been awarded to Wiliam Man-chester, author of "Death of a President," about the assassi-nation of President John F. Kennedy.

The Hammarskjold Cultural Prize went to Clare Boothe Luce, former U.S. ambassador to Italy.

The artistic prize was awarded to conuctor Leonard Bernstein of the New York Philharmonic Orchestra.

None of the three was present at the award ceremony yesterday at the ongress Palace of this Lake Maggiore resort. The pries, which consist of gold medals and a parchment, will be forwarded to the recipients.
