## Publication Of Mann's Studies Set

Thomas C. Mann, former Under Secretary of State, has been named a visiting scholar at the Johns Hopkins School of Advanced International Studies here, it was announced yesterday.

His studies, to be published as a book in 1967, will concern Latin American policy of the United States and will be "completely independent, reflecting Mr. Mann's own personal point of view," Dean Francis O. Wilcox said.

Before becoming Under Secretary of State for Economic Affairs, the Department's No. 3 post, Mann served in numerous economic and diplomatic posts in Washington, and twice as Assistant Secretary of State for Inter-American Affairs. His Embassy assignments included Montevideo, Caracas, Athens and Guatemala, and he has been Ambassador to El Salvador and Mexico.
