INFORMATION CONCERNING Obecassin iters

ED REID is a former newspaperman and author of "The Green Felt Jungle." who introduced SA GEORGE E.

REID called Agent on 5/6/67, having been referred ROSSILI, subject of an Anti-Racketeering investigation. It was agreed to meet with him on 5/9/67.

On 5/9/67, he mentioned and showed the rough draft manuscript of his new book entitled, "Jungle, U.S.A." which he described as a history and study of organized crime in the U. S. today. Concerning CARLOS MARCELLO, he wrote in effect as follows:

There was a meeting on 9/11/63, at Churchill Farms, outside New Orleans, Louisiana, of several people, including CARLOS MARCELLO, who made the statement that in order to get BOBEY KENNEDY they would have to kill the

President. They could not kill BOBBY because the President would use the Army and Marines to get them. This would result in BCBEY losing his powers as Attorney General because of the new President. They would get someone "peppered" up to do this job. Several days later, a person who attended this meeting was interviewed by FBI Agents of the Los Angeles Office and related what he had heard at Churchill Farms. The names of the Agents are known to the author. This is the extent of the paragraph concerning the assassination of JOHN F. KENNEDY.

REID said that his informant was reliable over the years and related this story to him about 18 months ago. After leaving New Orleans his informant traveled to Dallas and then to Los Angeles and several days later was interviewed by Bureau Azents concerning the BILLIE SOL ESTES case and allegedly related the incident at Churchill Farms. He refused to identify his informant, but said he would contact his source and see if his source was agreeable to making his name available to the FBI. The names of the Agents as furnished to REID by his informant were JIM ELDRIDGE and L. BLANTOX.

A search of the Los Angeles files disclosed that on 11/26/62, who had traveled from one light on the light of the light wherein mention was made of CARLOS MARCELLO. No other interviews by these Agents make any reference to MARCELLO. It, therefore, appears that the informant. In report of SA BLANTON dated 17,0002, page 14 - 16, the results of the interview with the set forth wherein it states that CARLOS MARCELLO was mentioned in connection with financing for a business proposition. No mention was made and of the assassination or a discussion concerning the Attorney Concral. Interviewing Agents have stated they definitely cid not receive such information from anyone interviewed. It should be noted that REID said the interview was conducted exeral days after the 9/11/63, meeting at Churchill Farms.

The interview with took place on 11/26/62.

REID was firmly advised that no such information was furnished to Agents of the Los Angeles Division as is alleged by his informant. He refused to confirm or deny that is his informant.



on 5/10/67, REID advised that he again contacted his informant to determine if he was agreeable to having his identity revealed by REID to the FBI. According to REID, the informant refused and persisted in his story.

REID declared that, although the FBI states that this information was not received from his informant, he will leave the story stand as is and that the book is now in the hands of his publisher.
