Hunt, Charging Libel, Files \$3.5 Million Suit

MIAMI, May J. (AP) W.R. Howard Hunt Jr., the convicted Watergts burgiar, filed a \$3.5 million libel suit in Federal courty esterday against Victor Marchetti, who had charged that Mr. Hunt had been involved in the assassination of President Kennedy.

Also named as a defendant was Liberty Lobby, publisher of a weekly newspaper called Spotlight Mr. Marchetti, who, like Mr. Hunt, is a former employee of the Central Intelligence Agency, wrote the article accusing Mr. Hunt of helping to plan the 1963 assassination. It was published in the Ang. 14, 1978, issue of Spotlight.

Mr. Hunt asked St million in compensatory damages, saying, "Circulation of libels and alanders concerning me have damaged me economically by closing many doors in the publishing industry and lecture circuit."

There was no immediate response from the defendants for the legendants.
