PROSECUTIVE SUMMARY REPORT OF SA JOE C. HESTER DATED JUNE 19, LAST, AT MEMPHIS HAS BEEN DISSEMINATED TO FBI, BIRMINGHAM, AND MIL M. CANALE, STATE AG, MEMPHIS, TENN.

SINCE PREPARATION OF SA HESTER'S REPORT, CONSIDERABLE PERTINENT INFORMATION OF POSSIBLE EVIDENTIARY VALUE HAS BEEN DEVELOPED BY LEGATS. IF NOT ALREADY DONE, IT IS SUGGESTED THAT ALL LEGATS BE REQUESTED TO PREPARE RESULTS OF INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED TO DATE IN FORM SUITABLE FOR INCLUSION IN PROSECUTIVE SUMMARY REPORT. LEGATS SHOULD ALSO BE INSTRUCTED TO OBTAIN ALL DOCUMENTS, INCLUDING MONEY ORDER USED BY RAY TO OBTAIN CANADIAN BIRTH CERTIFICATE, LETTER AND TEL OR MOTEL REGISTRATION CARDS ATTRIBUTED TO RAY FOR FBI LAB FOR HANDWRITING COMPARISONS.
