On 11/29/63 Mr. IYLA MAMANTOV, 6911 E. Mockingbird Lane, Dallas, Texas, reported that about 6 weeks or two months ago he received a phone call from ELIZABETH LEE GEALY, 503 Thompson Drive, Richardson, Texas, who asked him MAMANTOV, to take a Russian exchange student from somewhere in California into MAMANTOV home for two or three days. She stated the student was visiting in Dallas but did not to MAMANTOV's satisfaction explain the nature or reason for the student's visit to Dallas.

Mr. MAMANTOV stated that he refused to allow the student to stay at his home, therefore, he never learned the student's name. Further he told Mrs. GEALY that she should clear such requests with the FBI prior to calling citizens of Dallas regarding matters of this type. MAMANTOV said GEALY in making this call was acting for the Dallas Council for World Affairs.

**ACTION:** It is suggested a case be opened and ELIZABETH LEE GEALY interviewed regarding identity of Russian exchange student and nature of visit.
