I have just read a book that made me think of you again, a book I think may interest you because of Nancy Terrin Dick's testimony.

It is "Devil To Pay", by Robin Moore, that stalwart defender of the lower-echelon CIA types (meaning one who opposes the CIA as too moderate). Aside from being a successful businessman (airline operator in the Caribbean) and the author of "Green Berets" and "Jorgensy Team", he is also himself involved in anti-Castro activities and with anti-Castro types.

Devil is about Jack (Walter A.) Youngblood, mercenary, pilot, gun-runner, a man who worked with Castro and then turned against him, a man who quit the business temporarily when the CIA made flying hot but did so with the longing to become involved in a plot to murder Castro, and who hated him for many reasons, not the least of which is his belief that Castro owes him about a quarter of a million U.S. dollars.
