The telephone number code which Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison said he broke last week has yielded ~~the~~ possibility of at least three more significant numbers from Lee Harvey Oswald's notebook.

Two ~~reporters~~ reporters sat down with the Garrison cipher formula and translated the coded digits.

They came up with the locally-listed numbers of the Central Intelligence Agency, the Federal Bureau of Investigation and presidential assassination conspiracy suspect Clay L. ~~Shaw~~ Shaw.

Shown the results, Garrison confirmed the validity of the system's application and said his office ~~has~~ already had deciphered the same three ~~of~~ numbers.

The enciphered material has been public record for three years --- published on pages 38, 39 and 50 of the Warren Commission's Volume XVI, where Oswald's notebook appears in clear photographs.

Garrison announced Friday he had broken Oswald's code and had found identical numbers in Oswald's and Shaw's address books.

He said that it was the unlisted 1963 Dallas phone number of Jack Ruby, the man who shot Oswald to death in front of a nationwide television audience.

The Garrison-discovered code is a simple number reversal system which is masked further by the use of a standard deception number.

In most cases, the masking numbers Oswald used were 4900 and ~~the~~ <sup>1300</sup> numbers which Garrison said were easy for him to remember because they were associated with his life in New Orleans.

The DA pointed out that Oswald lived in the 4900 block of Magazine when he was here in 1963. Shaw, he noted in court pleadings, lives ~~now~~ in the 1300 block of Dauphine.

Now there is another cloak and daggerish turn to the District Attorney's investigation of John Kennedy's death.

It is a code. Deciphered, Jim Garrison expounded to Criminal District Court in New Orleans, from the address books of both his prime suspect, Clay L. Shaw, and Lee Harvey Oswald.

What the ciphers have revealed, if valid, is a startling ~~and~~ revelation ~~which~~ tends to confirm the DA's ~~former~~ conviction that Oswald was a federal undercover agent who was assigned to help the cause of anti-Castro Cubans here in the spring and summer of 1963.

Garrison sprang the code on the court in a formal answer to ~~Shaw's~~ Shaw's lawyers who asked for the return of their clients seized property, including an address book.

The DA demurred because he said the Shaw address book contained a number duplicated in Oswald's famous notebook, pictures of which are spread across the pages of the Warren Commission's exhibit Volume XVI.

In Oswald's notebook, it is P.O. 19106. In Shaw's address book, it is P.O. Box 19106. Garrison said the numbers are phony and added:

"When two parties have precisely the same nonexistent or fictional number in their address books, the possibility of coincidence is removed because of the uniqueness of a selected non-existent number."

In fact, the DA went on to say, the numbers are enciphered and, when deciphered, produce the 1963 Dallas telephone number of Jack Ruby --- the man who gunned down Oswald in the aftermath of Kennedy's murder.

What Garrison said he has found is a simple number reversal system which is masked further by the use of a standard deception with number:

~~XXXXXXXXXX, the masking numbers in Oswald's~~

He has proved the validity of the code, he declared, by applying it uniformly to several numbers in the Oswald

notebook and producing meaningful results. Three other numbers which he said he has decoded from Oswald's notes are those of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and Central Intelligence Agency offices at New Orleans and that of Shaw, himself.

How does it work, this code? It is really very simple.

In most cases the masking numbers Oswald used were 4900 and 1300, numbers which Garrison said were easy for him to remember because they were associated with his life in New Orleans. He pointed out that Oswald lived in the 4900 block of Magazine when he was here in 1963. Shaw, he noted in the court pleadings, lives in the 1300 block of Dauphine.

The system produced what Garrison said was Ruby's unlisted telephone at Dallas in 1963, Whitehall 1-5601. To arrive at that number, you must begin with P.O. 19106, the numbers found in both the Oswald and Shaw address books.

Decode with the rhythm: near (1), far ~~far~~ (6), near (9), far (0), near (1). You now have 16901. Subtract a standard masking number, 1300. The result is the Ruby number, 1-5601.

What about the exchange prefix? Garrison said Oswald used the standard telephone dial to encode prefixes, translating letters to numbers, and numbers to letters.

For instance, the letters P.O., on the standard telephone dial, look like this: P is 7, and O is 6. The sum of those digits is 13. The only prefix in Dallas which added up to 13 in 1963 was Whitehall --- W (9), H (4).

Thus, by decoding you have WH 1-5661.

To check the Garrison thesis, this writer and a colleague applied the same system to the other apparent ciphers in the Oswald address book. And while the system of notation differed slightly, the basic solution formula was the same in each case.

We showed the results of our work at Garrison. He affirmed it, and said his office had arrived at the same solutions.
