Fire at Perch Of JFK Killer To Be Probed

DALLAS, Aug. 5, — A county grand jury will investi-gate a fire that two weeks ago raged through the Texas Schoolbook Depository, perch of John F. Kennedy's assassin, a Dallas justice of the peace said today. said today.

ber, 1963. Justice of the Peace Robert Cole has referred the case to the grand jury after a prelimi-nary hearing for a building employee, Winfred Jack An-derson, to determine whether Anderson should be charged with aron. with arson.

Anderson, 25, was arrested July 28 by Dallas fire mar-shals and charged with setting fire to the historic building. He is free on a \$1,000 bond.

Anderson was employed as building manager by Nash-ville, Tenn., entrepreneur Au-brey Mayhew, who had planned to convert the infa-

planned to convert the infa-mous structure into a museum of Kennedy memorabilia. Capt. B. V. Gulley, a fire de-partment investigator, testi-fied that several five-gallon gasoline containers were found on the ground floor of the vacant building after the fire. fire.
