McConchy tered the industry several years

ago during his junior year at the University of Minnesota High school. His first venture was organizing a student tour to Mexico in cooperation with Regina Tours of St. Paul, Minnesota.

Following his Mexican jaunt, he continued working with Regina on a part-time and weekend basis. By his senior year he had sold approximately \$70,000 worth of travel, including two charter flights.

After his graduation in 1964, Malcolm began full-time work with Regina, traveling between St. Paul and the Chicago office selling group tours throughout the Midwest.

By now a specialist in groups and charters, he left Regina last year to join the aviation consulting firm of Bert Baker & Associates, carrier representatives, while continuing to sell special interest tours on a "freelance" basis under his own trade name, Creative Travel.

Last August, Malcolm made Milwaukee his permanent headquarters. He has continued his association with the Baker firm and plans to open a full-time office for his own operation.

Malcolm, who has completed the ASTA travel agency correspondence course, is studying law on a part-time basis. He was recently appointed a goodwill ambassador by the governor of Minnesota.
