On June 28, 1968, source two advised that on June 27, 1968, Oree McKenzie, Richard and Van Cabbage, Donney Delaney, Monroe Hinds Jr., Ben Berry, Melvin Smith, Arthur Norwood and Murrell McCullough elected Willie "Scoop" Rogers as the new Chairman of the Invaders. Source also advised that Oree McKenzie insisted that John B. Smith demand that the Invaders become more militant, and McKenzie said the new policy will be that of "head busting."
