The telegram in question reads "LEE OSWALD, City z Hall, Dallas. On television you requested counsel as you have not been able to obtain counsel and desire counsel. You may request a conference with me." Signed, M. MC DERMID, 1359 East 57th Street, Chicago, Illinois. The charge for this telegram was billed to telephone number NO 7-5703.

On November 25, 1963, records reflect that H. MC DERMID requested a report of delivery on the above telegram. On November 25, 1963, NC DERNID was furnished with the following message from Western Union, Dallas, via their Chicago office:

"Your telegram 23rd LEE OSWALD, City Hall delivered to Chief of Police. This is as far as our messenger allowed to go."

The above message was telephonically furnished Mrs. MC DERMID at 5:57 p.m. on Novembor 25, 1963, the telephone number NO 7-5703.
