

I have no computer and will not, not with this typing! Tried several times and gave it up. I've been using others who all seem to have different programs in their machines.

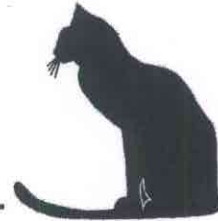
and, of course, I leave all that up to others.
