I've been going over some of the chapters chopped out of Hoaz/Case Open and inserting them into the Mailer book. When a discussed this brief with Jerry Yesterday

he expressed the belief that it can be worthwhile for students to see how writers sometimes are not faithful to the material and that they avoid what is public and easily available to them. That official bodies do the same thing with their own evidence, too. Some time ago Dave believed that my using that had published, which is from the official evidence, was an effective way of doing that.
