Enclosed find a brief file on Jack W. Martin of Goldonna, La., who was picked up as a suspect in Dealey Plaza and sent the Secret Service off on a wild hunt before LEO was even arrested. I have no idea of its significance. There is no follow up whatever on this, and it has always nig-gled at my curiosity. Possibly it might have some meaning for you.

I am re-reading all of the recently (Jan, 1971) declassified documents re LEO and Mexico. So far, nothing new or significant. Needless to say, if I find anything startling to bolster Sol, you will hear about it immediately.

At some juncture -- probably when the manuscript is finished -- we should discuss the most important "unanswered questions" that will be answered by the book. We will have to be selective on this as there are many, some of which may be less significant than I think.
