BELLAMANN

I quit business for good and returned to mathematics and, as a recreation, writing. My academic experience has been at the Universities of Washington and Chicago, at Harvard University, and at the California Institute of Technology. In 1910 I married Jessie L. Brown, a widow. She died in 1940. We had one son, Taine, now an M.D. In all I have published about 250 papers on mathematical research, one of which was awarded the Böcher prize in 1921 for mathematics in the preceding five years; nine books on the less inhuman aspects of mathematics, including mathematicians (of which *Men of Mathematics*, 1937, was awarded the Gold Medal of the Commonwealth Club); seventeen science fiction novels. The excuse for the last is that if they made money for publishers, some publisher might be interested in more serious books. It worked, and some have gone into several foreign languages."

James Warner Bellah was divorced in 1942 and married to Helen Hopkins. There are two children by this marriage, John Lauder and Stephen Hopkins. During the Second World War he served in the 1st and 26th Infantry Divisions and on the staff of Admiral Lord Louis Mountbatten at headquarters of the Southeast Asia Command, as an American officer. He had combat service

with General Stilwell, General Wingate, and Colonel Philip Cochran in Burma, and emerged from the war with the rank of colonel, the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star Medal, Air Medal, and Commendation Medal.

Bellah's numerous short stories and serials (which appear usually in the *Saturday Evening Post*) are now included in over twenty-five anthologies, and his works have been translated into fifteen foreign languages. One of his stories, "Command," was requested by the State Department for translation into the Thai language for the "This Is America" program. He has written technical articles on troop training for infantry, cavalry, and artillery journals. His screenplay adaptation, *She Wore a Yellow Ribbon*, was a successful motion picture. He also did the dialogue for the official Navy documentary film, *This Is Korea*.

Bellah received an M.A. in history from Georgetown University in 1945. He is president of James Warner Bellah, Inc., and vice president of the Lancaster and Chester Railroad.

Henry Bellamann died of a heart attack, at his home in New York City, at sixty-three.

Although he had been ill for several months, he worked up to the time of his death on a sequel to his enormously popular novel *Kings Row*. His plan was to write a trilogy encompassing the development of a small mid-Western town into a modern city. *Parris Mitchell of Kings Row* was completed by his wife, Katherine Jones Bellamann. *Time* referred to it as "a mass psycho-analysis . . . in language that seems lifted from a handbook of psychiatric clichés."

A *New York Times* critic observed that Bellamann seemed to have evolved a literary formula composed of "equal parts of Gothic melodrama and ideas."
