REBUTEL TO DALLAS MAR FOUR REQUESTING RE-INTERVIEW OF ATTORNEY

WILLIAM A. MC KENZIE.

MR. WILLIAM A. MC KENZIE, ATTORNEY FOR MARINA AND ROBERT OSWALD, ADVISED MARCH FIVE THAT INFORMATION CONTAINED IN DALLAS AIRTEL FEB TWENTYEIGHT LAST WAS FOR THE BUREAU'S INFORMATION ONLY. MR. MC KENZIE EMPHASIZED THAT UNDER NO CONDITIONS WOULD HE BE WILLING TO HAVE INFORMATION OF THIS NATURE DISSEMINATED IN VIEW OF THE FACT HE FEARED IT WOULD PLACE HIM IN EMBARRASSING POSITION AT A LATER DATE SHOULD HE REAPPEAR AT THE COMMISSION WITH EITHER OF HIS CLIENTS. HE STATES THAT HE HAS A STRONG FEELING, BUT NO POSITIVE INFORMATION, THAT EITHER ONE OR BOTH OF HIS CLIENTS MAY BE RECALLED. HE STATED THAT THE ONLY REASON HE FURNISHED THIS INFO IN THE FIRST PLACE WAS THAT HE HAS SUCH A HIGH REGARD FOR THE DIRECTOR AND THE BUREAU, AND WANTED THEM TO KNOW IT. HE ADVISED THAT THE COMMISSION IS WELL AWARE

THAT HE, MC KENZIE, THINKS THAT INFORMATION WAS LEAKED CONCERNING ROBERT OSWALD'S TESTIMONY, AND THAT MONDAY OF LAST WEEK RANKIN CALLED HIM AND ASKED HIM IF HE WOULD NAME ANYONE WHO HE THOUGHT WAS LEAKING INFORMATION. AT THAT TIME MC KENZIE STATED HE REFUSED SINCE HE HAD NO POSITIVE PROOF. HE STATED THAT HE DID NOT WANT TO TAKE A CHANCE OF BECOMING INVOLVED WITH ANY UNPLEASANTNESS WITH THE COMMISSION OVER INFORMATION THAT HE MIGHT BE FURNISHING THE BUREAU.
