Dear Jim and Geoff,

I'm getting to the end of the work required before Post Mortem can be printed. While it is at the printer's I'll be near both of you if either has any use for me or wants to talk to me other than by phone.

On the 19th I'll have a layover in Chicago on the way to speak and conduct some seminars at the Univ. Wisc. at Stevens Point. There are only a couple of Lake Central planes a day from Chicago. I remember an afternoon one I'd prefer getting because my recollections of weather there this time of the year discourage preference for night flying. (The last time they grounded the plane en route and I had a lousy, four-hour bus trip.) So - and I'm not assuming it - I Geoff wants to talk to me about anything, I can take an earlier plane to Chicago and have some time at the airport.

From there I go to Nashville for a debate with Belin. I'll be visiting Jimmy before the debate that night, the 22d unless there is a change in the schedule I've agreed to. If Belin consults anyone he'll back out. It is at Vanderbilt.

If Jim wants to spend any time with me or wants his researchers to I'm willing to go to KC from Nashville before going home and doing what I can to prepare to promote Post Mortem. The flight from Nashville can't be that long and if you are ready I think a day or part of one could be helpful.

I'm all for your project and I believe in earning my money!

(Geoff: much as we need it for the day-to-day we're using it or part of it so future books will look better. I've added new and significant content to this one, which is what held it up. It will be 660 pages and they'll look terrible.)

While I was able to prepare Al Lowenstein for his confrontation with Belin on the Suskind show, which I didn't see, I can do much more face-to-face with Belin, so I'm anxious to have a tape of that debate. Does either one of you have a Nashville or Vanderbilt friend who could make one for me? I think it not impossible that there could be uses for it.

Whether there can be literary uses I don't know. Historical I have no doubt. And not only on the Warren Commission. While I'll not have time to prepare I know enough to go into aspects of the Rockefeller Commission never mentioned in the media to my knowledge. Belin is a little understood man. He is a political psycho. He personally framed the case putting Oswald at the scene of both crimes and I have the evidence he suppressed that proves the opposite. I also have some Warren Commission files others have missed that, with proper investigation, would have led to the current CIA disclosures on drug abuses in 1964. Enough to suggest the same on assassinations, too.

I have already agreed to another debate with him at Binghamton, N.Y. I have a notion one will be enough for him. So, I'm anxious to have a tape if either of you can be of help with a local friend.
