There was no Alfred Scobey on the staff. That was a woman lawyer who when I last heard of her was counsel to the George State Supreme of Appeals, <sup>COURT</sup> probably appeals court. Her name is Alfreda and she was called "Fredda" by Russell. The story I've heard is that Rankin hired her to work for Russell when Russell planned to resign from the Commission. He actually wrote such a letter that he did not send. I have it.

We've not been in touch for a while. Last August <sup>Hood</sup> awarded Hil and me honorary doctorates.
