Yesterday I received your 10/30 tape. Don't worry about rewinding tapes. But when you find one that sticks use something like a Bic pen to put in the hub and start it past a point where it sticks. Sometime I can do this with my little finger.

I did not know that McMillan was on the Today show Tuesday at 10/26. Nobody has even mentioned it. Made no impact. What is the name of the black guy on with him? Ask NBC for a tape, in your own name. From what you say this sounds like one I've briefed, Donovan Gay. If so I'll be seeing him and I'll ask him. But you might want it and I think I do. You have a better chance because the book does mention you. Don't do it in Jimmy's name.

I have not seen the "ewsweek review either.

What Clerk did you write? What kind of suit are you thinking of filing? If you want to do anything like this speak to Jim and see if he can handle it. I don't want him to get bogged down in these kinds of things now but if they should be done let him do it. He is the only one who is a lawyer and knows enough and can be trusted. There are elements and angles you and Jimmy do not know. Jim can, for example, file in Washington right now. He's crazy if he lets Jimmy bog him down again, though.

You talk about filing in Tennessee. With the experiences we've had with judges there? Wrong, entirely wrong. Washington and Boston are best and Jim can handle Washington. Besides, you can't sue in Knoxville. You don't live there, they don't do business there so that court has no jurisdiction. Besides, you have to show more than \$10,000 in damages to get into federal court. But above all don't rush again and mess up like Jimmy did.

I've given you our schedule. We have enough time for a talk if you are at the gate and walk from one part of the airport to another. Have a cart with you. They have them. If Jimmy doesn't, Jim would be crazy to do more than he is in now. I learned the hard way, but not wanting to force Jimmy. I should have. All I did was argue. Nonetheless ask Jim what the meaning of the evidence I developed and he put in the record is for Jimmy plus what I am now getting is and can be...I've answered every tape I've received...let me borrow their cassette of George. And get the alligator-clip cord like I told you so the quality will be good. One clip goes on each connection to the TV speaker, the plug then goes into the microphone hole in the recorder.
