ON 4/27/74, GEORGE MC MILLAN, [REDACTED] CAMBRIDGE, MASS., ACKNOWLEDGED BEING AUTHOR OF MATERIAL ON JAMES EARL RAY BUT DECLINED INTERVIEW. STATES FENSTERWALD HABITUALLY MAKES WILD ACCUSATIONS AND HE DOES NOT FEEL ANY RESPONSE TO THESE IS WARRANTED. MC MILLAN STATES HE HAS WRITTEN LETTERS TO "JACK" WHO IS JOHN LARRY RAY, BROTHER OF JAMES EARL RAY. SECOND REASON FOR HIS NOT WISHING TO BE INTERVIEWED IS THAT CORRESPONDENCE BETWEEN HIMSELF AND JOHN LARRY RAY CONCERNS A SUIT IN FEDERAL COURT BY MC MILLAN TO GAIN ACCESS TO JOHN LARRY RAY, AN INMATE AT FEDERAL PRISON, MARION, ILLINIOS. SUIT APPARENTLY ON APPEAL TO UNITED STATES SUPREME COURT.
