**ASSAULTING A FEDERAL OFFICER**

Also enclosed for the Bureau is a newspaper article by PRISCILLA JOHNSON which appeared in the Sunday edition of the "Boston Daily Globe", 11/24/63 reflecting her interview with OSWALD.

For the information of the Bureau, in the course of the interview with Miss JOHNSON, she stated that on November 23, 1963, after hearing of President KENNEDY'S death, she telephoned a Mr. OWENS at the Russian Desk in the State Department at Washington, D. C. and told him of her inter-
