Q. I understand that Marina Oswald, whose husband assassinated John F. Kennedy, has written her autobiography in Russian. When will it be translated for readers in this country?—F.L., Dallas, Tex.

A. Marina Oswald has written no autobiography. Priscilla Johnson McMillan, who interviewed Lee Harvey Oswald in Moscow in 1959, was granted exclusive rights to Marina Oswald's story as far back as 1964. Since then Mrs. McMillan and Marina Oswald have collaborated on a book, "Marina and Lee," scheduled for publication in the U.S. in October. Mrs. McMillan previously translated into English "Only One Year," a book written by Joseph Stalin's daughter, Svetlana Alliluyeva.
