

Along with his usual garbage, in Joesten's 9/15 he quotes a letter that sounds much like Sylvia, an impression consistent with his introduction to it: "...I'm afraid that I gave up a long time ago on the idea that the truth concerning the assassinations would ever come out during the foreseeable future, if ever. I admire your tenacity! I, too, was tenacious for about seven years and now I have become resigned to the futility of even making a dent." The seven years would eliminate Sylvia unless she reached this conclusion then, which is also consistent with such. lsl 10/3/72
