That is what I had in mind. I have just raised this in general terms with Bud and Jim and will inform them of this.

Meanwhile, CIA has informed me that it has wiped out by their destruction all 1976 and earlier FOIA requests. This presents still other problems because mine are of that period. We've all been busy on other things so I've not had time to respond or take up with Bud and Jim.

Paul Hoch refers to a memo you prepared on Oswald/Mexico. If you have not sent me what he refers to I'd appreciate a copy.
