SUBJECT: BLACK ORGANIZING PROJECT (BOP)
aka Invaders

On 9/5/68 [redacted], Editorial writer, Commercial Appeal newspaper, advised SA WILLIAM H. LAWRENCE that about a week before he visited the Neighborhood Organizing Project (NOP) office, staffed by Invaders, at 1310 Florida. He met LANCE WATSON, aka "WILLIE WINE", and also saw JOHN HENRY FERGUSON. WINE claimed he is setting up an Afro School and Black History School, using material from Howard University, Washington, D. C.

WINE said BOP and Invaders is also using a lot of Black Panther Party material.

[redacted] said Commercial Appeal reporter CALVIN LEROY TAYLOR, a male Negro, is still a self-admitted sympathizer of Invaders, that CALVIN is close to a new Commercial Appeal copy boy, male Negro, RICHARD BOHNHAM, who is 5' 11", skinny, medium complexion.
