Poat Nortem: no need to pay for now. When you are out of Army I'II still have them because the only extant editions are zaraxes ( 0621 each). If I can get this printed the cost will be much less and the convenience much greater.

On the 2 film , also a aaution, LTFE regards it as their property. The only case of which I know where they have dane anything is with Tlink Thompson"s use, which I regards as provocative in intent. I was the firat to use and LIFE haan't protested in any way, but I used in responsible, scholarly way, even on TV. So, there is always the chance that some GI nut, knowine you have a oopy, may try to make trouble for you because the fact in that all available copies are copies of pirated copies.
