MEXICO CITY—As Mexico observed the 58th anniversary of its 1910 revolution against Porfirio Diaz, Alfonso Dominguez Martinez, head of the ruling Institutional Revolutionary Party, warned striking students their activities could lead to anarchy. He called on them to end their strike and join in working "for the progress of the nation."

As Martinez Dominguez spoke at the Plaza of the Revolution, riot police guarded approaches to the downtown area. At least 50 per sons have died in rioting against President Gustavo Diaz Ordaz's government. Some 10,000 students rallied Tuesday night in Mexico City and pledged to continue the strike they began last July.
