Happened at Saigon party given by CBS. General reached accross table and sais this to her. She said nothing worked, that only air power temporaririly prevented complete collapse, that the SVN army is spiritless, purposelyss and detached. No such thing as Vietnamization excapt as political phrase on Washington. All it means is the Americanization of the SVN Army, which means it is crippled and having neither purpose nor motive can even survive only because of overwhelming US Aair power. Asked how could thay hold out at An Loc she said they had no choice, anyone can hold out when he is cut off, has no other choice, and has such air power defending it, that there will never bem a sime when the SVN army will be able to make it on its own. Great phrase: The North Vietnamese haven't completed their sentence." She is the one who exposed the awarding of a medal for valor to a US general who had not been valorous, had done nothing to earn it. She said that when the story appeared the army regarded and treated her as less tham patriotic. Asked how she felt being back she said, "I don't think I'll ever be completely happy
