**The-Title-That-Needs-a-Good-Editor-Department:** The Jacobs Instrument Company, a new publisher in Victoria, British Columbia, is putting out a book called *A Scientist and His Experiences with Corruption and Treason in the U. S. Military-Industrial Establishment*. According to a press release, "this book, an autobiography, tells of the experiences of a physicist who was running his own weapons systems development company in the U. S. from 1948 to 1958. During the Korean War he had under development, for the U. S. Navy, a weapon he had conceived which would have altered drastically the course of that war. Yet some firms

that wanted to get access to the design secrets of this company got the Navy to use the utmost pressure to get this firm to merge with them. When the owner refused, the contract for this weapon development was terminated. The case was investigated by two Senate committees and the White House . . . the matter went up to the Supreme Court. Finally the scientist's company was seized. This book gives an acute and perceptive insight into the workings of the military-industrial establishment, and reveals a tremendous amount of information on how it operates that has not been made public before." *ASAHEWCATITUSMIE* will sell for \$30 and was written by the president of the publishing company.
