Thanks for your letter and the copy of the article. Plural.

After Case Open Posner had to do a bit about Failure Analysis. He did it in a long footnote that made a not great publishing problem. They photographed the hardback and used it for the paperback. It meant he had to eliminate some of the text and make some changes in source notes and the index.

He dared not have an epilogue. The minor changes are that many! Awfully sloppy work despite its appearance.

You saw how little he could say about me. And he made that up anyway. Case Open is my 13th commercial edition, four of which were first printings.
