The past 10 days have not been the best. Otherwise I'd ~~we~~ have written you sooner to say my supply of Oswald in New Orleans is down to only four copies.

In yesterday's mail id a letter from a man who bought one. He told me that pages 234-7 are missing. I checked one of those that remains and they are missing in it. I'm sending him those pages.

It amounts to one sheet, front and back.

After several days of feeling less well last Monday, the 7th, I asked the physical therapist to take my blood pressure. It was high, 200/85. I phoned the local cardiologist. He did not tell me to come in. He told me to take two of one of the medications instead of one. I've been doing that. Wednesday I asked the physical therapist to take the pressure again. It was again 200/85 but when he took it after I used the exercycle a half hour it was down somewhat. This past Friday it began with OK pressure but when I finished with the exercycle it was again high. So, go figure!

I got in all about 10 hours of sleep last night and after being up a little more than an hour feel like taking a nap. I've done that several times recently.

Otherwise we are about as we were. The weather is turning cooler. There were frosts around us but we've had none.

Hope all is going well with all of you.
