APTHERER.

FE ATELLIOR J. EDGAR HOOVER, IN CONGRESSIONAL TESTIMONY LAST JULY, IDENTIFIED CAMP MIDVALE AS A CENTER FOR INDOCTRINATING COLLEGE STUDENT AND OTHER YOUTHS IN COMMUNIST FRONT TACTICS.

AMONG TEATHS CONFISCATED WERE MORTARS, BAZOOKAS, MACHINE GUNS, SEMI-ARBOHATIC RIFLES, HOMEMADE BOMBS, MACHETES, GARROTING NOOSES AND A MILLION ROUNDS OF AMMUNITION.
