He can tell you of Shand's disappearance, what he told Allan before he disappeared, what the wife said, and a lot of other matters.

If you have no knowledge of the pistoleros, Allan can tell you of them also, and their possible importance in Lyndon Johnson's political life. They may, in fact, have made it possible for him to become President.

I'll be more preoccupied than usual for the coming week. However, if there is anything else you know of in the Archives, tell me and I'll get it for you.

Please allow no public use of the attached. I plan to use some of it soon.

Anything else I can do? My newspapers clippings on these boys are sent.
