Mitchell Plans to Visit Campuses

Attorney General John N. Mitchell, who has advised government to improve its communication with students, will head a list of top Justice Department officials visiting about 50 college campuses next month.

"We're not going out there to sell the Nixon Administration and we're not out there campaigning," a spokesman said. "We're out there to discuss the issues that affect the Justice Department."

He said the issues would include crime, civil rights or any other matters the students or faculty want to bring up.

Mitchell won't visit all 50 campuses, the spokesman said, but will accompany some of the seven teams of department speakers.
