Dear Senator Mondale:

I am sure that he will make every effort to arrange something convenient to both Mr. Jasper and himself. In addition to the assassination of President Kennedy, he has much information on the assassination of Senator Kennedy, and that of Martin Luther King also. In addition, he is very knowledgeable about the political maneuvering which followed these assassinations, not to mention the activities of Haitian and Cuban exile groups in the southern areas of this country which violate the expressed policies of the United States.

I would like to reiterate my offer to present my slides and film footage to you, your family, friends, or associates, should any decide to see it out of curiosity or interest. I expect to be in Minnesota for at least two more years finishing up my academic work, and am at your disposal for at least that period of time.

Thanks again for your interest in a subject which now seems so remote and unimportant to those who don't consider the broader questions it raises.
