Dear Harold

FYI only - Kodak has agreed to do any photographic work necessary on Moorman to assist JPL's analysis. Also, assuming there really are convincing images, Kodak will also do its own computer analysis. The advantages to this joint effort are; 1) both companies can serve as checks on the other; 2) both have special computer programs the other may not, and 3) Kodak can scan the print directly, whereas JPL needs a transparency <sup>(Kodak to make)</sup> which, of course, puts them 1 generation away.

We will bring both your print and Tink's and use whichever one they determine is best. We had an April 15 date set, but have had to postpone till the end of April.
