Cyclists Wanted In Slaying Case Seized in Ga.

ATLANTA, May 5 (AP) — Three members of the Hell's Angels motorcycle gang were placed under \$10,000 bond each today and sent to the Fulton County Jail to await the arrival of California authorities who have charged them with murder and assault.

U.S. Commissioner Frank A. Holden said the three San Francisco members of the Gypsy Jokers Motorcycle Club, which the FBI lists as a chapter of the Hell's Angels, waived a hearing at their arraignment.

The three, Michael L. Gimelli, 22, William Gary Duran, 27, and Terry Wayne Jones, 22, were picked up by FBI agents, Atlanta and DeKalb County officers during the weekend on Federal charges of interstate flight to avoid prosecution on the San Francisco charges.
